Kids: Who can change our hearts so that we no longer want to sin? (*Psalms 51*)

Students/Adults: How can we serve the Lord wholeheartedly? (*1 Kings 12:8-17*)

Week 5 Day 1

Kids: Why did the religious leader believe he was better than the tax collector? (*Luke 18*)

Students/Adults: How are warnings of discipline an example of mercy? (*1 Kings 9:4-9*)

Week 5 Day 2

Kids: What was the tax collector's prayer focused on? (*Luke 18*)

Students/Adults: How does patience with each other show God's mercy? (*1 Kings 11:29-37*)
